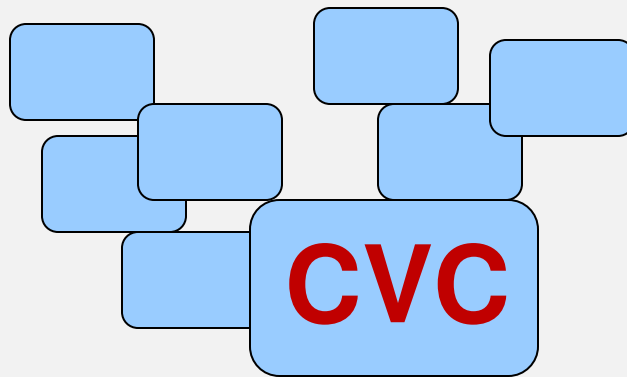

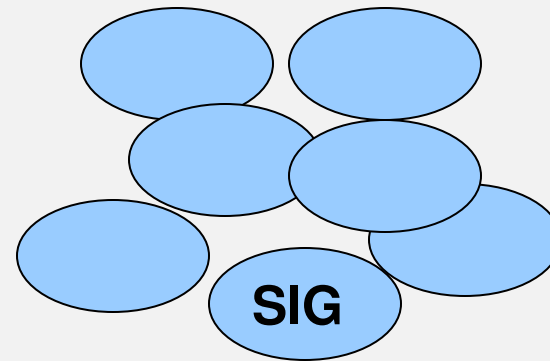

- ❖ 1996 - The Chapter was formed with 25 members
- ❖ 1998 - Awarded the PMI Chapter Member Growth Achievement Award for Region II at the Council of Chapter Presidents Leadership meeting in Long Beach, California
  
- ❖ 2000 - Membership had grown to 392 members, of which 71 were Project Management Professionals (PMPs)
- ❖ 2001 - Celebrated our five-year anniversary
- ❖ 2002 – Celebrated our 500th member
- ❖ May 2005 - Recorded our 1000th member
