### How to join?

To be a member of the Central Virginia Chapter you must first be a member of the Project Management Institute (PMI). All membership is handled through the PMI web-site at [www.pmi.org](http://www.pmi.org). New individual membership dues are \$129, and annual renewal is \$119. Once you have joined PMI, be sure to add the chapter. The CVC chapter dues are only \$25.

Once you are a member of PMI you can join any number of components. You can be a member of multiple chapters if your business or your life takes you around the country or around the globe. You can join global specific interest communities that concentrate on your career area or interest.

### Student?

If you are enrolled in a degree-granting program at an accredited (or global equivalent) college or university, you may join PMI as a student member.
